

Offences within Schedule 1 to the Children and Young Persons Act 1933 and the Schedule to the Disqualification from Caring for Children Regulations 2002, and other offences relevant to Appendix E

Offences against children or young persons listed or treated as listed in Schedule 1 to the Children and Young Persons Act 1933

Common law offences

- Murder or manslaughter of a child or young person under 18
- Common assault, or battery

Offences under the Offences against the Person Act 1861

- s5 Manslaughter of a child or young person under 18
- s27 Abandonment or exposure of a child under 2 so as to endanger the child's life or so as to injure the child's health permanently or be likely to do so

Offences under the Children and Young Persons Act 1933

- s1 Cruelty (including assault, ill-treatment, neglect, abandonment or exposure in a manner likely to cause unnecessary suffering or injury to health) to a child or young person under 16
- s3 Allowing a child or young person under 16 to be in a brothel
- s4 Causing or allowing a child or young person under 16 to be used for begging
- s11 Exposing a child under 12 to risk of burning
- s23 Allowing a child or young person under 16 to take part in a dangerous performance endangering life or limb

Offences under the Infanticide Act 1938

- s1 Infanticide

Offences under the Suicide Act 1961

- s2 Aiding, abetting, counselling or procuring the suicide of a child or young person under 18

Offences under the Protection of Children Act 1978

- s1(1) Taking, distributing, having or publishing an indecent photograph of a child or young person under 16

Offences under the Child Abduction Act 1984

- s1 Abduction out of the United Kingdom of a child or young person under 16 by a parent, guardian etc.

s2 Abduction of a child or young person under 16 by a person other than a parent, guardian etc.

Offences under the Sexual Offences Act 2003

s1 Rape or attempted rape of a child or young person

s2 Assault by penetration or attempted assault by penetration of a child or young person

s3 Sexual assault or attempted sexual assault of a child or young person

s4 Causing or attempting to cause a child or young person to engage in sexual activity without consent

s5 Rape or attempted rape of a child under 13

s6 Assault by penetration or attempted assault by penetration of a child under 13

s7 Sexual assault or attempted sexual assault of a child under 13

s8 Causing or inciting a child under 13 to engage in sexual activity, or attempting to do so

s9 Sexual activity or attempted sexual activity with a child or young person

s10 Causing or inciting a child or young person to engage in sexual activity, or attempting to do so

s11 Engaging in a sexual activity in the presence of a child or young person, or attempting to do so

s12 Causing or attempting to cause a child or young person to watch a sexual act

s14 Arranging or facilitating, or attempting to arrange or facilitate, the commission of a child sex offence

s15 Meeting or attempting to meet a child or young person following sexual grooming etc

s16 Abuse of a position of trust: sexual activity or attempted sexual activity with a child or young person

s17 Abuse of a position of trust: causing or inciting, or attempting to cause or incite, a child or young person to engage in a sexual activity

s18 Abuse of a position of trust: sexual activity in the presence of a child or young person, or an attempt to do so

s19 Abuse of a position of trust: causing, or attempting to cause, a child or young person to watch a sexual act

s25 Sexual activity, or attempted sexual activity with a child family member

s26 Inciting, or attempting to incite, a child family member to engage in sexual activity

s30 Sexual activity, or attempted sexual activity, with a child or young person with a mental disorder impeding choice

s31 Causing or inciting, or attempting to cause or incite, a child or young person with a mental disorder impeding choice, to engage in a sexual activity

- s32 Engaging in sexual activity in the presence of a child or young person with a mental disorder impeding choice, or attempting to do so
- s33 Causing, or attempting to cause, a child or young person with a mental disorder impeding choice, to watch a sexual act
- s34 Inducement, threat or deception to procure sexual activity with a child or young person with a mental disorder, or attempting to do so
- s35 Causing a child or young person with a mental disorder to engage in or agree to engage in sexual activity by inducement, threat or deception, or attempting to do so
- s36 Engaging in sexual activity in the presence, procured by inducement, threat or deception, of a child or young person with a mental disorder, or attempting to do so
- s37 Causing, or attempting to cause, a child or young person with a mental disorder to watch a sexual act by inducement, threat or deception
- s38 Care workers: sexual activity with a child or young person with a mental disorder or attempting to do so
- s39 Care workers: causing or inciting sexual activity with a child or young person or attempting to do so
- s40 Care workers: sexual activity in the presence of a child or young person with a mental disorder or attempting to do so
- s41 Care workers: causing a child or young person with a mental disorder to watch a sexual act or attempting to do so
- s47 Paying for sexual services of a child or young person or attempting to do so
- s48 Causing or inciting child prostitution or pornography or attempting to do so
- s49 Controlling a child prostitute or a child involved in pornography or attempting to do so
- s50 Arranging or facilitating child prostitution or pornography or attempting to do so
- s52 Causing or inciting prostitution of a child or young person for gain or attempting to do so
- s53 Controlling prostitution of a child or young person for gain or attempting to do so
- s57 Trafficking of a child or young person into the UK for sexual exploitation or attempting to do so
- s58 Trafficking of a child or young person within the UK for sexual exploitation or attempting to do so
- s59 Trafficking of a child or young person out of the UK for sexual exploitation or attempting to do so
- s61 Administering a substance with intent to a child or young person, or attempting to do so
- s62 Committing an offence with intent to commit a sexual offence against a child or young person, or attempting to do so

s63 Trespass with intent to commit a sexual offence against a child or young person, or attempting to do so

s66 Exposure or attempting to do so

s67 Voyeurism or attempting to do so

Offences under the Domestic Violence, Crime and Victims Act 2004

s5 Causing or allowing the death of a child or young person

Other Offences

- Any other offence involving bodily injury to a child or young person under 18

Offences specified in the Schedule to the Disqualification from Caring with Children Regulations 2002

(Other than offences listed above and offences relevant to Scotland and Northern Ireland.)

Offences under Sections 44(15), 49 or 50(9) of Children Act 1989, , or Section 32(3) of the Children and Young Persons Act 1969

Intentional obstruction of a person executing an emergency protection order, abduction of a child or young person, or obstruction of lawful recovery of an abducted child.

Offences under Section 79D of the Children Act 1989

Failure to register as a child minder

Offences under Section 70 of the Children Act 1989

Offences in respect of private fostering.

Offences under Sections 11(1), 24, 25, 26 and 27 of the Care Standards Act 2000

Offences in relation to a children's home of failure to register or comply with conditions, contravention of regulations, providing false descriptions of establishments and agencies or false statements in applications
