What is the course about?

The course gives a solid and strong grounding in the basics of youth work, and is recognised as an access course by the country's top Youth Work Training College The Centre for Youth Ministry.

This course opens the doors for further professional training in Youth work should you want to do it. If not then just do this course!

How do I enrol?

What are the course contents?

1. Starting Out : Youth work basics, definitions, youth work's nature, government definitions, the heart of youth work, 'Christian' youth work, and some course basics + details.
2. Safe and Sound : Child Protection, Health and Safety, and Risk Assessment.
3. Outside in : Looking at working with excluded + non churched young people, substance abuse, culture, and young people's perception of church.
4. Inside Out : Working with churched young people, youth congregations, youth worship, discipling young people.
5. Staying in : What keeps young people in church, issues of power and integration, role, relevance, and responsibility.
6. Looking forward, looking back Planning and evaluating, special needs, challenging behaviour and conflict.
7. Moving on : Further training options, planning & measuring youth work.

When is the course held?

The course is split into 7 modules It runs on Saturday from 9.30-3.30 and one module is covered on each Saturday.
