

## **Draft Agreement**

### **As a school, we will:**

- Seek to develop further our high standards and expectations concerning the teaching and learning of pupils with regard to Personal, Social, Moral and Health education, including collective worship and the teaching of RE, enhanced through this partnership agreement, for the benefit of all the young people in our community
- Seek to celebrate and acknowledge the importance of spirituality and faith to our school life
- Seek to build on existing relationships with the local Anglican church
- Support events organised by the local church. And help publicise these where possible.
- Acknowledge the affiliation with the Diocesan Board of Education in materials produced and published by the school
- Offer support and advice to other church schools in the Diocese at the invitation of the Diocesan Board of Education.

### **As a Diocese, we will:**

- Offer support and advice to the school, particularly in areas of specialist expertise
- Invite the school to participate in appropriate training opportunities
- Visit the school periodically, in the spirit of shared enterprise, upon invitation from the Headteacher and on request

### **As a local Church community we will:**

- Seek to support and enrich the spiritual life and worship of the school, in consultation with the Headteacher and the Governing Body
- Maintain and develop our existing strong links with the school in close co-operation with the Headteacher and the Governing Body
- Support events organized by the school and help publicise these where possible
- Regularly pray for the school
- Offer pastoral support to individual pupils, staff and families where appropriate, to provide spiritual support in times of need, serious illness, bereavement etc
- Acknowledge the affiliation in materials produced and published by the Church
